SUMMARY

Moves, positions, and stages **53 foot trailers** with hostlers and **3 axle tractors**, including careful converter dolly connections and disconnections. Loads and unloads time sensitive freight with forklifts, **pallet jacks**, and other powered or manual equipment. Uses handheld devices for shipment scanning, tracking, and location accuracy. Maintains safe work areas around trailers, pedestrians, powered equipment, changing dock conditions, and slippery surfaces. Comfortable with outdoor work, variable freight volume, rotating day, evening, night, and weekend schedules, frequent lifting, climbing, bending, pushing, pulling, and extended standing.
